Who Can Participate??

Sport Capoeira athletes from any country all over the world with no limit to the number of athletes from any one nation may compete in the competition from ages 10 and up.

TRANSPORTATION

Who will pay for my transport??

Flight tickets and ground transport in Baku are the sole responsibility of the participants (athletes, coaches, media, spectators etc.) The organizing committee works with sponsors and does everything possible to ensure shuttle transport from and to the Heydar Aliyev international airport as well as collectively transfer from hotels to venue in the competition days (1-3 May, 2020). However, all transport cost will remain in responsibility of the participants unless otherwise noted.

You can use public transport of Baku city (buses and metro) by approximately \$0.20 cents from point A to point B.

All other citizens shall obtain a visa beforehand.

Participants will settle the visa issue on their expense.

There are 2 simple ways to obtain visa to Azerbaijan for the "[BAKU OPEN 2020](#)" [International Capoeira Tournament](#).

The first way is to apply for e-visa (sample of e-visa). **This is the most convenient way to secure an entry visa to Azerbaijan.** The advantages of e-visa is lower cost, online process only (no need to visit embassies or send your passport to them), you get a visa to your email as PDF attachment that you just need to print out. You can enter Azerbaijan at any border entry point with this type of visa. One can apply for e-visa for up to 1 year before the planned entry date to Azerbaijan.

The cost of e-visa is only 20\$ for all nationals and it takes up to 3 days to be ready. The visa will have 30 days validity starting from the day that you put as your arrival day to Azerbaijan in request form. To apply directly one should proceed to <http://evisa.gov.az/> and will only need to fill visa request form, upload a scan of the passport, pay a visa fee and then wait when it is ready and emailed to applicant's email address. You might enter Azerbaijan later than the visa start day but within the 30 days validity period. Electronic visas will be issued only to nationals of 81 countries (<https://evisa.gov.az/en/countries>).

The second way is to apply for visa in a traditional way through the embassy/consulate of Azerbaijan Republic abroad. To obtain a visa in this way you will need an official Letter of Invitation from local National Capoeira Federation of Azerbaijan.

In 2017, the ASAN visa portal was launched in Azerbaijan. For a length of stay in the country of up to 30 days, a one-time electronic visa can be obtained from the portal and is available within 3 working days after payment and sent directly to the applicant's e-mail. The state fee is 20 US dollars for a visa. Applications for electronic visa via the portal are intended for individuals, families (at least 2, maximum 10 people) and groups (minimum 10, maximum 300 people). The simplification of visa procedures has a positive impact on the flow of tourists into the country. After the introduction of electronic visas, the number of tourists arriving in Azerbaijan increased by 24 percent in 2017. Bear in mind that, visa

procedures in international airports of Azerbaijan for citizens of the United Arab Emirates have been simplified since 2015; for citizens of Kuwait, Qatar, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Japan, China, Bahrain, the South Korea, Malaysia, Indonesia and Singapore since 2016. After the introduction of electronic visas, the number of tourists coming from European countries has also increased. In addition, according to statistics, about 70 percent of visitors are citizens of states that enjoy a visa-free regime with Azerbaijan. www.evisa.gov.az

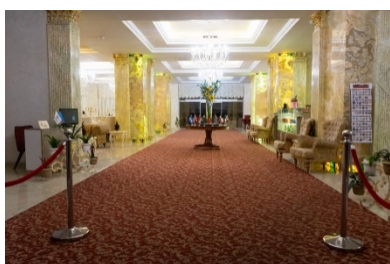
ACCOMMODATION

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be organized on 1st of May, 2020 from 13:00 to 19:00. All participants of the event (Athletes, coaches, referees, press, fans and others) have to pass Accreditation process. Accreditation staff will take weight and necessary documents of athletes and delegates.

After accreditation all participants will receive appropriate badges which will give them entry permission to the venue.

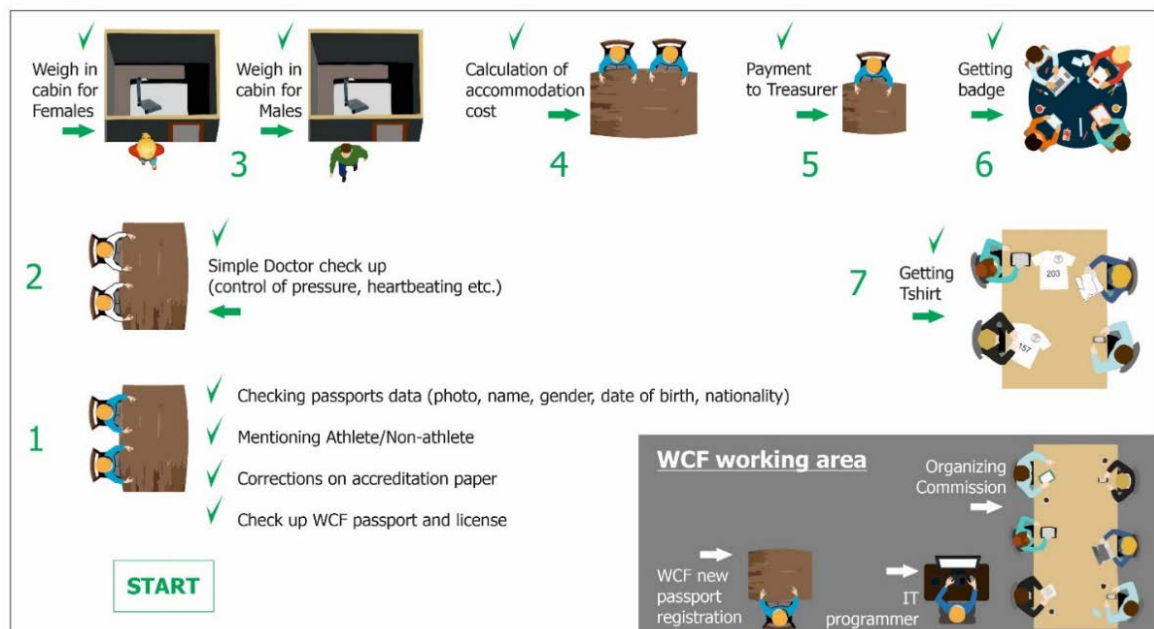

AWARDING

Medal and diploma.

Every day at the end of the competitions the award ceremony will take place. All competitors having won a medal have to attend the ceremony to receive their medal in person. If a competitor is absent during the awarding ceremony for no valid reason, he/she will lose the right to have the medal. It is permitted for competitors on the podium to bring national flag. Any demonstration of political sign and any other advertising which is not sanctioned due to WCF Competition Rules is prohibited.

Competitors who will take 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in the competitions will be awarded respectively with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals and diplomas by Organizing Committee.

Cups.

Besides the individual victories, at the end of the competition a cup will be presented to the winner national federation or team: to the head of the national federation of the country, more athletes of which will firstly win the gold, silver and bronze medals

"BAKU OPEN 2020" International Capoeira Tournament will be run according to the **WCF Competition Rules**. The application of rules will be the responsibility of the Referee Panel with international referee qualifications of WCF.

INSURANCE

No insurance is concluded for the participants (athletes, coaches, support personnel etc.) related to the competition. We draw explicit attention to the fact that all participants and members of the individual delegations have to take out their own personal insurance (liability insurance, health insurance, travel insurance etc.). The organizing committee will not assume any corresponding cost and rejects any form of liability.

FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE

All National Federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in this event have to respect and accept the authority of the WCF officials, the rules and statutes of the World Capoeira Federation. Individuals deemed to have acted against the WCF or Referees, their principles or purposes shall be subject to

suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.

ABOUT AZERBAIJAN

The Republic of Azerbaijan is the largest country in the South Caucasus Region and is located at the crossroads of Asia and Europe on the western shore of the Caspian Sea. It's bounded by the Russian Federation to the north, Georgia to the northwest, Armenia to the West the Islam Republic of Iran to the South and Turkey to the Southwest. The Caspian cost size is 713 kilometers in length. In addition to the mainland are located a few small Iceland (Absheron archipelago) belonging to Azerbaijan. Azerbaijan covers an area of 86.6 thousand square km and has a population of 10 million people. The Azerbaijan Democratic Republic was established in 1918 and was the first country in the Muslim world to recognize women's voting rights. Unfortunately, in 1920, Azerbaijan found itself under Soviet authority This continued until 18 October 1991 when the Republic of Azerbaijan regained its independence. The landscape of Azerbaijan consists of mountains, lowlands and plains. In the north of the country rises The Greater Caucasus Mountain Range with the lesser Caucasus to be found in the south-west. The highest point of the republic is Bazarduzu in the Greater Caucasus Range (4466m), The central part of the country covers the Kura-Araz, The South-East the Lankaran lowlands. Mountain lakes likes Batabat, Maraljol and Goygol possess their own unique beauty. Many natural mineral springs have been revealed in Azerbaijan - the most famous are - "Badamly" and "Sirab". The fauna and flora of Azerbaijan are also rich and diverse. 9 out of 11 of the worlds climatic zones can be observed in Azerbaijan.

The Republic of Azerbaijan includes the following territorial - administrative divisions - Nakhchivan Autonomous Republic, 65 districts, 69 cities, 14 city districts, (12 in Baku, 2 in Ganja), 130 settlements and 4354 villages. The reason for the theritory of the Nakhchivan Autonomous Republic being seperated from the mainland is because of border changes implemented in 1920 by Soviet authorities. In that year the Zangazur region of Azerbaijan was granted to the Armenian SSR and consequently the Nakhchvan Autonomous Republic became separated from the rest of the country. The Nagorno - Karabakh region of Azerbaijan and 7 surrounding districts have been occupied by Armenian armed forces since the early 90s.

Port City of Baku – Welcome to our beautiful capital!

Baku, one of the most beautiful world's cities is located at the joint of Europe and Asia. The capital's name itself is interpreted as a "wind blow", "city of winds" or "hill", "city on the hill".

The port city of Baku, the cultural, industrial and political capital of Azerbaijan is located on the western Caspian seaside, on the bay shores of the same name in the southern part of the Absheron Peninsula, rich in its oil fields. Baku consists of 11 administrative districts and 5 townships.

Baku is the largest cultural center of Azerbaijan. It is the place where a national theatre, the first in Muslim East, lifted the curtain, the first opera was performed, the first Azerbaijan newspaper was published, the first Azerbaijan library was opened. Today Baku is known to have 30 museums, 7 theatres, 11 institutions of higher education, philharmonic, opera theatre, film studio, cinema theaters and

libraries housed in the city's most beautiful buildings having an interior decoration which is every bit as good as their interior cultural content.



Climate

Azerbaijan is a fascinating country with its rich, unique, natural beauty and stunning shades. 9 out of 11 major climate zones on Earth can be witnessed here. The country is situated at the junction of moderate and subtropical zones, so the climate is varied. The average temperature in May varies from +20 to +28 degrees and reaches +30, +35 degrees in July and August. Precipitation is low.

Language

The official language is Azerbaijani. Azerbaijani belongs to the Turkish group of languages and at the same time is very close to the Turkish accent. The vast majority of the population speak Russian fluently. In hotels, bars, shopping and business centers, English is also used.

Photo and Video shooting

You can take the usual tourist photos and videos (with the exception of some objects), but while taking a photo of strangers on the street or in any public place, as a matter of courtesy, it is advisable to ask permission.

Working hours

Weekends are usually Saturday and Sunday (mainly for public offices, Additionally, official holidays are days off. Private companies sometimes operate on Saturdays. The vast majority of the shops and supermarkets are open daily. Working days start between 8am and 9am, commercial facilities close between 9pm and 11pm, restaurants and bars - much later.

Media and Information

In Azerbaijan, 9 national and regional TV channels are available, as well as various radio stations. In addition, via satellite and cable TV, you can watch the channels of numerous countries all over the world. Hotels also offer a package of local and foreign channels. Besides many local newspapers and journals, periodicals in English and Russian are available.

Medical Services

At state Medical Center's emergency help is provided free of charge. The ambulance service is available 24 hours a day by calling (012) **103**. There are also many private medical clinics and centers where the vast majority of doctors know English some pharmacies are open throughout the night.

Communications and Internet

There is a high level of communication services, At the hotels you can call internationally, use fax and internet services. In the city there are many coin operated payphones. The Internet is also developing rapidly all over the country Mobile communications on the GSM 900 standard operate all over the country There are three mobile operators in Azerbaijan: Azercell, Bakcell and Nar mobile. The international dialing code for Azerbaijan is: + 994, Baku 12.

Security

Azerbaijan is the most stable and secure country in the region. Law and order are present in the streets of cities. Azerbaijanis are very law-abiding and friendly people and respect other people's traditions and customs. Tourists feel very comfortable here.

Issues related to Armenia and Azerbaijan, Nagorno-Karabakh conflict

The Nagorno-Karabakh region and seven surrounding districts of Azerbaijan are currently under the occupation of Armenian armed forces. Therefore, foreign tourists visiting Nagorno-Karabakh through Armenia are perceived negatively in Azerbaijan. Visiting occupied territories is in contravention to international law and considered as an illegal visit. If tourists have visited Nagorno-Karabakh and there are relevant records in their passport, they will not be given a visa to come to Azerbaijan. This issue should be approached with patience and in all seriousness in order to show respect to the feelings of Azerbaijanis. Moreover, Azerbaijan can not ensure the safety of tourists in the occupied territories.

Currency

The national currency is the **Manat**. Exchange of any currency is possible in banks and many exchange offices. Banks are usually open on weekdays (some on Saturdays) from 10 A.M. to 5 P.M. Money Exchange: Heydar Aliyev International Airport (Everyday 24/7): Gunay Bank currency exchange points in an Old City Shah Palace Hotel & Fountain Square (Everyday 10 a.m. - 10 p.m): ASB Park Bulvar (Everyday 10 a.m. 9.30 p.m): GunayBank 24/7 at Hilton Hotel Baku, Holiday Inn Hotel; Currency Exchange Machines 24/7 at Faimont Baku Flame Towers, Four Seasons Hotel Baku, JW Marriott Absheron Baku Hotel Bank Respublika Azneft 24/7 - 67, Neftchilar ave.

How to reach Baku??

By Air: Heydar Aliyev International Airport (IATA: GYD) is situated 25 km (15 mi) from Baku city centre. It is served by major airlines including Aeroflot, Austrian Airlines, Azerbaijan Airlines (AZAL), Turkish Airlines, Lufthansa and Qatar Airways, and a whole host of smaller airlines.

By road: International buses runs from Turkey and Iran to Baku.

By train: Overnight trains are available from Russia and Ukraine on daily basis to Baku.

By ferry: Ferries operate between Baku and Russia, Iran, Kazakhstan, (Irregularly, approximately every 7-10 days), and Turkmenbashi, Turkmenistan. The phone number of the sea terminal (Daniz Vagzal) is +994 12 447 7314.

Make sure you have appropriate visa before departure (embarking)!!!

Recommendations about public transport

Bus: City buses cost 30 gapik ($\pm 0,17\$$) per ride. For most services you pay cash as you get off. However, the sleek new red buses only accept prepaid "Bakı Kart" credit.



"Bakı Kart" can be purchased at metro stations and at certain bus stops. There are two versions of the card – a plastic one costing 2 Manat ($\pm 1,17\$$) plus credit that can be reused, and a disposable paper one allowing up to four credits (i.e. four rides will cost 1 Manat). For now, "Bakı Kart" system is only used by the metro and the newest red buses, but it is likely that the system will be extended in the future.

Many Baku bus routes are shown in detail on www.gomap.az – click 'Avtobuslar' in the left-hand panel and choose the route. The Google maps app route finder works fairly well in Baku and www.nim.az claims to give real-time info about the next bus arriving at any stop, though it often seems unduly pessimistic. Beware that routes seem to change every year or two and the maps don't always stay updated.

Metro: The metro links the Old City (Icheri Sheher metro station) via the train station (28 May metro station) with a series of suburban stations, most usefully Sahil, Ganjlik, Koroglu, Qara Qarayev and Neftchiler metro stations. Fares cost 30 gapik ($\pm 0,17\$$) regardless of distance. Prepay credit onto to the "Bakı Kart" system.



Taxi: The majority of taxis that wait street corners are not metered, many demanding around 5 Manat ($\pm 2.93\$$) minimum fare. However, the metered London-style cabs, are an exception with a flag fall of only 1 Manat and very sensible kilometer rates.

For longer rides call Taxi 189 which charges 3 Manat ($\pm 1.7\$$) minimum for up to 3km, or 3.80 Manat for 4km plus 50 gapik per km. You need to preorder by phone and they'll quote the total fare in advance.

"Uber" and "Bolt" mobile taxi services are available in Baku.

TAX FREE SYSTEM IN AZERBAIJAN

СИСТЕМА TAX FREE В АЗЕРБАЙДЖАНЕ

The Tax Free system used internationally when dealing with tourists has just been launched in Azerbaijan. In order to benefit from the Tax Free option, one must present receipts of transactions for purchased goods whose total value should be no less than 300 AZN (including the value-added tax). In Azerbaijan, for all goods, value-added tax is equal to 18%. For each purchased item, 20% of the value-added tax will be withheld as a service fee and the rest will be reimbursed. The item must be taken out of the country within 90 days following the purchase, after which the value-added tax will no longer be reimbursed. On leaving Azerbaijan, one must present the items and their receipts at customs. Payment can be made either in local or foreign currency. Tax Free is not extended to the following: excise goods, grocery items, medications and pharmaceutical items, objects constituting the country's historical and cultural heritage, objects exempt from value-added tax at the time of purchase, objects which require a license in order to be exported out of the country, unaffected, unsorted and unsorted gemstones, bar-shaped pieces of precious metals, goods transported in unaccompanied baggage, vehicles and their spare parts. The Tax Free system is in operation in all international airports of Azerbaijan. In the future, this system will be available at all border checkpoints. Currently, the Tax Free system is connected to more than 250 shops and shopping centers.
