The "Budapest Open 2022" International Capoeira Tournament will take place on **15-16<sup>th</sup> of January (Saturday and Sunday) from 09.00 am**. Accreditation will take place on January 14<sup>th</sup> between 17:00-19:00.

Registration for participation is ongoing and it will close on 10th January 2022!

Event will be organized by the World Capoeira Federation Organizing Commission.

Athletes who take 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places (there are two 3<sup>rd</sup> positions for **Under 18 categories**) will be awarded respectively with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals and diplomas. Winner nation (by quantity of gold medals) will receive a special trophy from Organizing committee. There will be also participation certificate for all participants of the event. Also, regardless of the place taken, all athletes who participated in at least one match will gain world ranking points.

Preparation for the championship continues and many volunteers are putting tremendous amounts of effort into the success of this event.

## ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be organized in SZENT MARGIT GIMNAZIUM on 14.01.2022 between 17.00-19.00. All participants of the event (Athletes, coaches, referees, press etc) have to complete Accreditation Procedure. Accreditation team will take weight and necessary documents of athletes and team members.

After accreditation all participants will receive appropriate badges which will give them entry permission to venues.

Only accredited representatives of media will be allowed to film the competition.

### **GROUPS AND WEIGHTS**

Except the above mentioned groups an amateur and non-ranking competition for kids Under 10 will be organized by the Organizing Committee.

### IMPORTANT:

Maximum 32 players will compete in each group.

The category that has less than 4 registered participants will be merged with it's closest comparable category or it will be dissolved by decision of the Organizing Commission of the WCF.

#### SAFETY, INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

The Organizing Committee assume absolutely no liability in the event of a purely

sporting accident involving any participant. The Organizing Committee declines all responsibility in case of injury, in case of riot or any disaster which occurs during the Competition. Each participant of the Competition should be insured for the abovementioned accidents and occurrences, by its own organization in its own country, with cover for all risks that may be incurred abroad during travel and participation.

For safety reasons, the use of a sports **mouth guard** is highly recommended.

## **ATTENTION to COACHES!!!**

(extraction from the WCF competition rules no 19)

- Delegates, team leaders and coaches undertake the responsibility over the discipline of the athletes and team members involved in the competition, and they shall ensure that the athletes and team members participate in the competition in a timely manner.

- During the competition, coaches must sit in the chair provided and must not interfere with the smooth running of the matches by word or deed (coaches will be able to sit 2 meters away from tatami to support their athletes).

- Due to the behavior and rule violation, any delegate or another member of the team may be ejected from where the competition is held and the relevant competitor may receive the next warning regarding this.

- Coaches shall at all times during a competition, wear the official tracksuit of their National Federation and display their official identification. Female coaches may wear religiously headwear of a type approved by the WCF for referees and judges.

## THE DRAW

Bracket Draw will take place on 15th January in the morning after Accreditation fully completed. Competitors will be allocated into category brackets according to their age, gender and weight. The Draw to determine which players will be paired against which players within a Bracket will be generated randomly by an automated computer program.

## AWARDING

At conclusion of each last round, an award ceremony of the groups will take place where results are known.

The winner of the medal must attend the ceremony in person in order to receive his/her medal. If a competitor is absent during the awarding ceremony for no valid reason, he/she will lose the right to have the medal.

It is permitted for competitors on the podium to bring national flag. Any demonstration of religious or political sign is prohibited. Any other advertising which is not sanctioned due to WCF Competition Rules is prohibited.

Competitors who will take 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places (there are 2 third places) in the competitions will be awarded respectively with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals and diplomas by Organizing Committee.

## WINNER Cup.

Besides the individual victories, at the end of the competition a cup will be presented to the winner (by quantity of gold medals) national federation or team.

## **COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS**

"Budapest Open 2022" International Capoeira Tournament will be held in accordance with the **WCF Competition Rules**. The application of competition rules will be responsibility of WCF licensed Referees with international referee qualifications.

**Important**: In amateur categories Under 10 Tesoura (in all variations) are prohibited.

#### **FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES**

All National Federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in this event have to respect and accept the authority of the WCF officials, the rules and statutes of the World Capoeira Federation. Individuals deemed to have acted against the WCF, their principles or purposes shall be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.
